The National AAHAM Scholarship Program requirements are listed below. The Florida Sunshine Chapter eligibility requirements are posted on our website at <http://www.floridaaaham.com/scholarships.html>. Additional information will be distributed soon.

SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE

The National AAHAM Scholarship Program provides for two (2) classifications of awards. The primary emphasis is on a member who submits an application and meets all the eligibility requirements. Consideration will be given to an application submitted by a spouse, child or grandchild of a member. The awards are classified as follows:

1. Member scholarship award

- Member must have been a member of National AAHAM for at least one year and be a current member as of March 31st of the application year.
- Maximum amount of award is \$2500 per year, which shall be less than or equal to the cost of tuition and related expenses.
- No more than two (2) awards shall be given per year for this program.

2. Spouse, child or grandchild of a member scholarship award:

- Must be spouse, child or grandchild of a National AAHAM member who has been a member for at least one year.
- Maximum amount of award is \$1,000 per year, which shall be less than or equal to the cost of tuition and related educational expenses.
- No more than four (4) awards shall be given per year for this program.

*No member, spouse, child or grandchild may receive more than one award.
Applications that meet the established criteria will be considered by a review and selection committee comprised of the National Practice and Standards Committee.*
