SELECTION CRITERIA:

- Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) for completed semesters of college or high school. If application has not completed at least 24 credit hours of post high school courses, the high school GPA will be used. Proof of GPA (official transcript) must accompany application. **(Maximum: 8 points)**
- Number of years of experience working at a paid position within a healthcare related field. Please detail position, employer and exact dates of service. Partial years up to 9 months receive no credit. **(Maximum: 5 points)**
- Majoring studies with the intent of graduating in business, accounting, management, or healthcare related field. **(Maximum: 5 points)**
- Current Major:
- AAHAM Certified Manager, including CRCE, CRCP and CRCS certifications. **(Maximum: 5 points)**

List Certifications:

- Professional achievements, including honors, activities, and participation in community and civic affairs. Attach additional pages as needed. **(Maximum: 10 points)**

Please attach a current transcript and any additional information that may be of value to the scholarship committee. All eligible applicants shall be scored by the Scholarship Committee. The highest scoring applicant(s) shall be selected and presented with the award at the Fall Conference.



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APPLICATION

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicant must be currently attending and/or enrolled for an upcoming term at an accredited college, university or trade school.
- Applicant must be an active member of the Florida Sunshine Chapter or part of a member's immediate family.
- Completed application and most recent official school transcripts must be submitted and received by the Scholarship Committee no later than August 1st of the current year so that winners can be announced in the fall.
