As chief spokesman and lobbyist for the profession, Paul met with leaders from both parties on the issue of reform. He has been a tireless champion in the fight to protect every citizen's right to petition their government through lobbying activities. Paul has traveled abroad to talk with foreign leaders about their efforts to implement lobbying rules and regulations. He has met with leaders from Peru, Indonesia, Great Britain, Viet Nam, Czechoslovakia, Italy, Scandinavia, Poland, and Japan. He has appeared on NBC Nightly News, ABC News, C-Span, CNN, MSNBC, The News Hour with Jim Lehr, and Lou Dobbs discussing ethics and transparency issues.
